Annual Report (2022 -23)

The college is progressing every year. This year a total of 915 students are admitted in the college. There are 15 regular, 10 extension staff in teaching and 18 non-teaching staff members during this year. Dr. Anita Rani Associate professor Geography retired. Dr. Rekha joined Geography Department. Mrs. Lailta Assistant Professor of Commerce and Mr. Mehar Singh Assistant Professor of Geography have successfully completed their Ph.D.

Extension Activities -

NSS - Our students are engaged in community activities through NSS unit. Our college adopted two villages, Bupania and Balor Under Unnat Bharat Scheme. Various activites organized under plastic free Haryana scheme. One Seven Days Camp (Village Balor) and two one day Camps (College Campus) were organized with the objective of cleanliness of sports ground, watering trees, Yoga. Practice to attain good health. An extension lecture on balanced diet and good health was organized. Students were taught to prepare Jute Bags, Phone Covers, Bottle Covers and Paper Bags. Free health Checkup Camp for students was organized by NSS Unit. Two of our students participated in one week awareness campaign on Sign language in M.D.U. With the help of local administration one day cleanliness program was organized in college.

Women Cell - The college has an energetic women cell that organizes various activities to empower the girls in all spheres of life. Whether it is Professional development, physical fitness, mental fitness or social cultural activities. An extension lecture on the topic Communication Skills and Personality Development was organized by the cell to build a culture of positive communication and to improve efficiency. The cell organized a Seven Day Art and Craft Workshop. The students learnt about Clay Work, Pencil art, terracotta jewellery, wood carving, sketching and painting.

Cultural Committee - The cultural committee brings out the creative side of the students. A talent hunt program and cultural fest "Ullas" were organized by the cultural committee. Various activities were conducted in these programs like, solo dance, group dance, debate, rangoli, poster making, best out of waste, Clay modeling, poem recitation, shalok ucchharan, skit etc.

Sports Committee – The College has an active sports committee. The students participated enthusiastically in various events during Annual Athletic meet like race, high jump, long jump, fancy dress etc. Dr. Raj Rani Bansal was the chief guest on the meet.

Placement Cell: - Placement cell looks after the Professional interests of students. Dr. Ashwani Goyal' Associate professor, Placement officer 'The Technological Institute of Textile science Bhiwani delivered Lectures on Career Guidance and Placement.' And by Dr. Sanjay Nandal, Associate professor, IMSAR, M.D.University Rohtak delivered lectures on the topic 'Career Opportunity in Management' by Dr. Shalini Singh, Professor, Dept of Psychology M.D.U Rohtak delivered lectures on the topic of 'Intervention to enhance Capacity Building in Students'.

NAAC: - A Motivational talk was organized on the topic of 'work ethics and time management'. The talk was delivered by Mr. Sanjeev Vasisth, motivational speaker. The college is under the process of the accreditation by NAAC and submitted IIQA. Which is now approved.

Road Safety/YRC/Red Ribbon Cell: - The cell conducted one day workshop on 'First Aid and Disaster Management'. The cell also conducted an awareness program on road safety and cyber crime. Road safety week is celebrated by road safety club with different activities like, pledge drive, poster making Competition, Road safety theme based lecture by 'IDTR Employees'. Two students participated in one day seminar on Drug Abuse held in Vaish Arya Kanya Mahavidhyalya.

Mentorship programme: - The objective of mentorship program is to support students in improving their learning skills and motivating them towards their career development. In this program discussions were made on various topics like Health and Hygiene, Preparation of Examination and significance of Basant Panchmi, Student clubs constitution.

Library – The College has a good library with 6320 number. of books. This year 618 number of books were added in the library.

Scholarship- The College distribute Scholarship under various schemes provided by Govt. of Haryana. This year many students received benefits under SC/ST, Post metric Scholarship, BC & Other Scholarships.
