### **Special Attractions of the Year**

#### **NAAC**

With the efforts of IQAC, NAAC committee and the entire staff of the college we got NAAC accreditation for the first time this year with Grade 'B' and CGPA score of 2.16. The IQAC Co-ordinator is Dr Rajesh Kumar and Dr Shilpa was the NAAC Coordinator.

## **IQAC**

A Discussion Forum was constituted under the IQAC for the purpose of improving the cognitive skills and further growth of faculty members. ## **Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)**

In order to improve the soft skills of students, the college signed an MOU with NIMAYA and Workverse. A 5 week “Smart Fellowship” programme was organised in the college with their collaboration. ## **Extension Activities**

### **YRC/Road Safety Club**

An Awareness Rally on "Drug Abuse" was organized by YRC/Road Safety Club in which students also took oath regarding Drug Abuse. The club also conducted a Quiz competition regarding Road Safety Rules in collaboration with Traffic Police Management Bahadurgarh and also Organized "Fortnight Campaign" from 24.01.2024 to 26.01.2024 in order to celebrate National Youth Day including various activities such as HIV awareness rally, Slogan writing competition and Extension Lecture on HIV awareness

### **Women Cell**

Women Cell is working in the college to provide a safe and supportive environment for female students, address their consensus and promote gender equality on campus. Ms. Mona is the convenor of this cell and Dr Seema and Mrs. Reena are members. Various activities viz. Rakhi Making, Mehandi Competition, Extension Lectures were organized to empower the female students.

During session 2023-24, Rakhi making event was organized to celebrate festival of Raksha Bandhan in which 17 students participated and made beautiful eco-friendly Rakhis. Mehandi competition was organized to celebrate the festival of Karwa-Chauth in which 13 students participated and best 3 designs won prizes. An extension lecture was organized on the topic "Gender and Society". Dr Promila Batra Prabha was the resource person, who is a consulting Psychologist and professor retired from Department of Psychology, M.D.U. Rohtak. Total 65 students participated in this extension lecture.

Another extension lecture was organized on the topic "Prevention of Sexual Harassment at Work Place". Dr Priney Chaturvedi was the resource person who is an academican, lawyer, feminist and author. She is working as Assistant Professor in Department of Law at Gurugram University. Total 84 students participated in the lecture.

Women's day was celebrated by organizing extension lecture on the topic "Stress free Life by Rajyog Meditation and Satvik Lifestyle" which was conducted by Prajapati Brahma Kumari's Ishwariya Vishwa Vidyalaya in

collaboration with AYUSH department, Jhajjar. Mr. B.K. Lovekesh, Naturopath, Yog Therapist, dietitian, Ms. B. K. Indu, Ms. B.K. Rubi were resource persons. More than 100 students and staff participated in the extension lecture. A discussion was also organized on the topic “Women Empowerment” in which all faculty members participated and a healthy discussion was held.

### **Mentorship**

There are 18 mentorship groups in our college. Dr Sudesh Rathee is the Chief mentor. Mentor, mentee ratio is 1:47. There is one mentorship class in every month in which each mentor interacts with his/her mentees on various topics. Mentorship class is a platform provided to the students, where they can discuss their problems and queries with their mentor.

### **Earn While You Learn**

Dr Sudesh Rathee is the incharge of the Earn while you learn scheme. Under this scheme, our college received grant of Rs. 40000. 16 Students worked under this scheme in Library, Labs, Placement Cell, Women Cell, Office and Sports Committee. Meritorious and needy Students were given priority for the selection in this scheme.

### **Placement Cell**

The Placement cell organized six days Employability Skill workshop under the Mahindra Pride Classroom of NANDI foundation. Under the inchargeship of Dr Sunita Chhillar the cell also organised a four days Startup Introduction camp in collaboration with SAAC India. Various topics such as Entrepreneurship, market research, creating business canvas, story-telling etc. were discussed in the camp. Ms. Shweta Rajput and Ms. Smriti were the main speakers of the camp and 65 students participated in the camp.

### **NSS**

Our college has a NSS unit. Dr Seema is the NSS program officer, under her efficient direction the following activities were conducted during this session:

8. **7 Days Special Camp** was organised from 22nd December 2023 to 28th December 2023 by conducting various activities, extension lectures, a rally and cultural programs.
9. An awareness campaign on the topic **'My First Vote for the Country'** was held on 13th March 2024.

### **ECO Club**

To provide shelter and food to birds, efforts are made by the NSS volunteers throughout the year for their water and food. Bird nests were also made by the NSS volunteers and hanged on trees.

### **CULTURAL Committee**

To develop the cultural consciousness of the students, cultural committee organized various activities throughout the year under the guidance of convenor Dr Seema and members Ms. Mona and Mrs Reena, in which the students participated enthusiastically.

1. **'Talent hunt'** program was organised on 8th September 2023. Haryanvi, Punjabi, Rajasthani, Gujarati and Marathi group dances and solo dances were performed by the students. Other activities during this program were folk songs, Haryanvi Gajal, Bhajan, Solo Songs, Sanskrit Shloka recitation, Hindi, English, Haryanvi poems recitation, Rangoli, Painting, Poster Making, Best Out of Waste, Clay Modelling.
2. **A district level youth festival** was held at PG Nehru College Jhajjar. Our students participated in solo folk song, Haryanvi solo dance, poster making, photography, declamation (Hindi, English), just a minute and story writing competitions.

**Sports Committee** – The College has an active sports committee. This year we celebrated 7<sup>th</sup> Annual Athletic meet. Ms. Manisha won the title of best athlete During the meet various events such as 100meter race, 200 meter race, 400 meter race, 800 meter race, three leg race, chatty race, high jump, long jump, discuss throw, javelin throw, 100 meter teaching staff race, non-teaching staff race, musical chairs etc. were organized. **Library** – The College has a good library with 6527 number of books. This year 207 books were added in the library.



**Scholarship-** The College distribute Scholarship under various schemes provided by Govt. of Haryana. This year 236 students received benefits under SC/ST, Post metric Scholarship, BC & Other Scholarships.

**Commerce-** The department organized a group discussion on Impact of social media on youth and 13 students participated enthusiastically in the discussion.

**Psychology-** An Exhibition was held in the Department in which 30 students took part and displayed beautiful models. Two students participated in Inter-district level Science Exhibition at Govt. College, Gurugram.

**Political Science-** Voter awareness rallies, oath taking and awareness campaign were held under election commission of India programme "Mera Pehla Vote Desh Ke Liye".

**Sanskrit-** 'Skit Stories', "Sanskrit-Shabd-Antakshari", Story Writing and various creative activities were organized in the department. 25 students applied for scholarship given by 'Kendriya Sanskrit Vishwavidyalaya' established under Parliamentary Act of Indian Government.

**Mathematics-** A departmental activity in which 'Mathematics Puzzles' and 'Sudoku' competition was held. The students of B.A and B.Sc. participated enthusiastically in the competition.
